

# Carrara Marble Epoxy Recipe

## Step-by-Step



Lightly sand with 220 grit sandpaper  
Sand gingerly on the edges by hand



Wipe the sanding dust off your countertop



## Carrera Marble Epoxy

Stone Coat Countertop Epoxy

White Metallic Powder

Black Metallic Powder

1/8" Square Notch Trowel

Mixing bucket

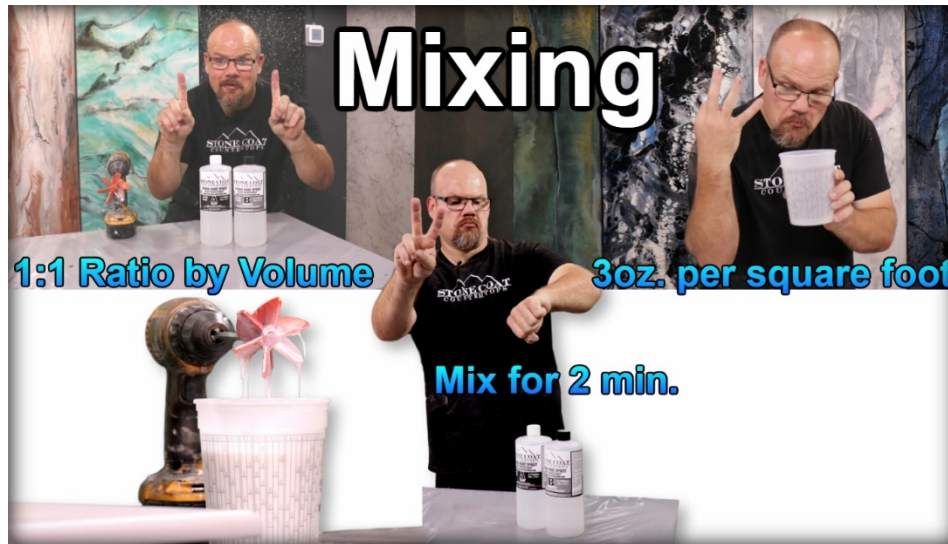
Drill, mixing paddle

Chop Brushes

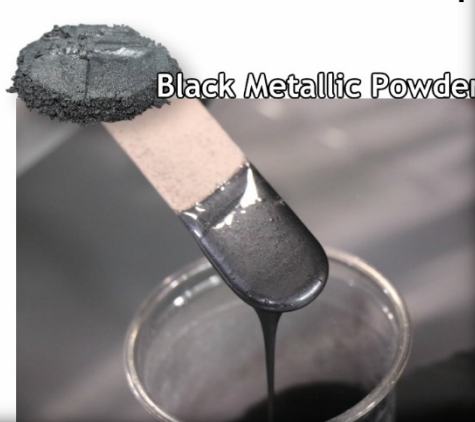
Gloves

## Check List





In the larger mixing cup mix white metallic powder  
Mix black metallic powder into the small cup



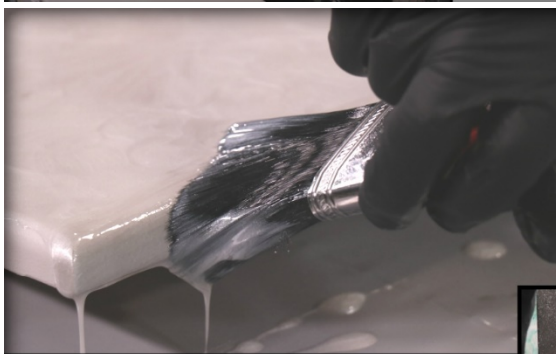
Pour the white epoxy out in the center of the project. Use a 1/8" notch trowel to spread the epoxy evenly







Remove trowel lines by randomly chopping the surface with a chop brush



Use a propane torch or heat gun to remove air incorporated into the epoxy while mixing & chopping

Use your chop brush to apply epoxy to the edges



Marbleize the project by chopping in black metallic randomly with your brush

Create a vein with black  
metallic epoxy  
Chop the vein to  
blend & meld



**Paint with Air**

Meld your project with a  
**Heat Gun**  
as desired
